COMPLETE CLOSURE OF NORTH ROCKS ROAD NOTICE:

From 8pm Friday 11 July to 5am Monday 14 July 2025

There will be a COMPLETE CLOSURE of North Rocks Road between Church St and the Woolworths entrance, except for pedestrians and buses.

The suggested detour for those normally coming up from (or down to) the bottom end of North Rocks Rd is via James Ruse Rd, Pennant Hills Rd, Bettington Rd/Statham Ave to the top end of North Rocks Rd and then down to the Church (or the reverse).

This detour is about 7km and you should allow an extra 15 minutes drive time on Sunday morning, and more at other times.

Access to and from Woolworths car park will only be from the North.

Night works will also be carried out at other times during July and August, but with only slight traffic delays expected.

Just last month, a young family came to Meals Plus after hearing about our food hampers. By the time they walked through our doors, the pressure was immense. They were skipping meals—sometimes for days—just so their children could eat. Denise quietly admitted she'd often cried when opening the fridge, wondering how she would get through another week.

That first hamper made an immediate difference. "It felt like someone finally saw us," she said. The food was important—but so too was the message that they weren't alone Denise began returning each week, collecting groceries and essentials that helped stretch their budget just a little further. At the same time, we helped the family negotiate with their landlord, preventing another rent increase that would have pushed them past breaking point.

"It's still tough with prices going up, but now we're managing. That little bit of help gave us the push we needed," Denise said.

Stories like this show us what's possible when the right support is available at the right time. And right now, more people than ever need that support.

Reflection of the Week

God's Ambassador

In most cases, our citizenship to the country in which we live is bestowed upon us for simply being born into that country. Receiving citizenship into God's Kingdom requires us to surrender our "citizenship" to this world and devote our lives to following Christ. Becoming a citizen of God's Kingdom results in some incredible benefits.

However, we must remember that wherever we go in the world, we are ambassadors for Christ. Just as your behaviour in a foreign country gives others an idea of what people from your country are like, so our behaviour as believers tells the world what it means to be a Christian.

Citizens from God's Kingdom carry with them the answers to some of life's most difficult questions. The dying world in which we live is desperately seeking to find meaning and purpose in its existence.

As believers, we are infiltrating enemy territory, armed with the Truth of God's Word, which will defeat the enemy's tired, empty propaganda. Those people who are desperate for answers cannot afford for believers to live passively in their faith.

We must be wise in our approach yet gentle in our speech. Threats of eternal condemnation will not change many lives, but the Truth about how God's love washes away our sin will transform the hardest of hearts when the Holy Spirit is at work.

To live in a world that is far from our home certainly presents a number of challenges. But our citizenship in God's Kingdom empowers us to live in such a manner that God will use us to radically change the world around us.

Prayer: Lord, use me to make an impact in the world around me as I passionately seek You. I pray in the name of Jesus. Amen.
